That includes almost 20,000 Meals on Wheels deliveries and 10,000 lunches at the Center.

Medicare Enrollment with Zenaida Thursday, October 10 at 1:00 pm

Join Zenaida to go over all the different parts of Medicare and how they work. She will explain the ins and outs of supplements (Medigap plans) and Advantage (Part C) plans.

You will also go over the changes to Medicare for 2025. Learn how Part D will work next year. An opportunity to schedule a one on one to go over personalized options for yourself based on your doctors and medications will be available to you. Don't miss this important discussion with Zenaida!

Patient Choices Vermont Wednesday, October 16 at 1:00 pm

Brigid will lead an open discussion about end-of-life decision making including medical aid in dying under Vermont's Act 39. This is an opportunity to learn, ask questions, and share stories. These conversations are life affirming and empowering. People often discuss their experiences with the dying process of loved ones and express their desires for what they would or would not like when they consider their end-of-life choices. Topics will include medical aid in dying, who qualifies, and

how it works, as well as the role of hospice and palliative care. Brigid will discuss how to talk to your doctor and recent legislative updates to Act 39.

SNIP Presentation Wednesday, October 30 at 1:00 pm

SNSC Special Need Information Program, or SNIP, is a voluntary safety program that helps emergency responders identify and respond to vulnerable residents with special needs. The benefits of the program to our most vulnerable citizens and to law enforcement make it an invaluable safety tool for our community. The tool is free to residents and provides local law enforcement with essential information prior to an emergency.




Bon Voyage to Captain Paige
